Day Camp FAQ's

How much does it cost to bring my dog to camp?

\$35 per day

\$400 for 20 day pre buy card (\$20 per day, our best value!)

\$250 for 10 day pre buy card (\$25 per day)

\$125 for 5 day pre buy card (\$25 per day)

What vaccinations are required for my dog to join camp?

Rabies, Bordetella (kennel cough), & Distemper vaccines are required in order to enter our facility. These vaccines must be up to date & given at least 7 days before you plan to start camp.



Does my dog need to be spayed or neutered to come to camp?

No, we accept intact dogs into our program! We create play groups every morning & intact dogs are always kept separate from each other. If they cause issues (humping or a target for humping) they are removed from the group & re-evaluated. We can have them 1:1 with a staff member or a small group of dogs or they may do better going out alone in a private play yard. We do advocate for spaying & neutering dogs when they reach appropriate age but this is not required to attend our facility.

Can my dog come to camp if they don't like to play in large groups?

Absolutely! Some dogs prefer to play 1:1 with another dog or in a very small group of 2-3 dogs. We have lots of "supervised doubles, triples, & quads" as we call them. These dogs thrive on small group play & often don't do well in large groups. Sometimes this is a great way to get dogs used to playing with other dogs & they can eventually graduate into regular group play.

Can my dog come to camp if they don't like other dogs?

Absolutely! We have private play yards for dogs who need to go "out alone" where they can see other dogs but cannot interact with them directly. We also have lots of enrichment options that you can add on to your dog's day of camp to give them some additional stimulation in place of group play.

How do playgroups work?

The dogs go out to play with other dogs of similar age, size, & activity levels (if your dog is a puppy they will only be placed with other puppies or play 1:1 with a staff member until they reach a year of age). The play groups are created each morning by our experienced team to ensure that all dogs are in the appropriate group. Play groups are pretty small in size generally about 10-15 dogs per group but a lot of the time they are even smaller than that. Groups are evaluated during lunch time to make appropriate changes for the afternoon playtime so everyone is playing with an appropriately matched group.



Do you have indoor and outdoor play spaces?

We do! Almost every day the dogs are playing outside in our large sandy play yards. Each yard is filled with an assortment of play structures for the dogs to enjoy. In the warm summer months we have pools & hoses for the dogs who enjoy water! On the inclement weather days we do have a large indoor play room so the dogs don't have to be out in bad weather but still get to run around & play.



What does the day look like for a dog attending camp?

The drop off window for camp is from 7-9am during our open lobby hours. A staff member will meet you in the parking lot to walk your pup inside. The dogs are in private lodgings during drop off hours & group play begins at 9am. The play groups are always supervised by at least one trained staff member, the majority time two trained staff members are supervising each group. We are rotating through the play groups all morning long with a scheduled nap/lunch time between the hours of 11:30am - 1pm. All of the dogs are exhausted & take full advantage of this time to take a power nap before afternoon play groups begin. Lunch is fed at noon for those dogs requiring it. Starting at 1pm we repeat the play group rotations all afternoon until the dogs return to their private lodgings for pick up time. Pick up in the afternoon is between 4-6pm during our open lobby hours.
