Summer Has Arrived!

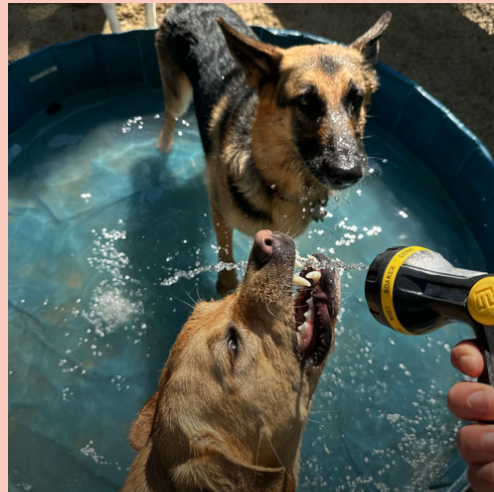

Watch for Heatstroke

Recognizing the signs of overheating or heatstroke in dogs is crucial, especially during the hot summer months. If your dog shows any of the following symptoms, take action immediately:

- Excessive panting or drooling
- Bright red, pale, or blue-tinged gums
- Rapid heartbeat
- Lethargy or weakness
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Disorientation or unsteadiness
- Collapse or unresponsiveness

Move your dog to a cool, shaded area, offer small amounts of water, and contact your veterinarian right away—heatstroke is a serious emergency that requires prompt care.

Summer Safety

Summer storms and fireworks can be scary for many dogs, but with a little preparation, you can help ease their anxiety. Here are some simple ways to keep your dog calm and safe:

- Create a safe, quiet space indoors where your dog can retreat.
- Close windows and curtains to reduce noise and flashing lights.
- Play calming music or use white noise to help mask loud sounds.
- Use anxiety wraps, pheromone sprays, or calming treats if helpful.
- Ensure your dog's ID tags and microchip info are up to date.
- Keep your dog indoors during fireworks displays and storms.

If your dog experiences severe anxiety, contact your veterinarian early to discuss options like prescription medications or long-term calming solutions—don't wait until the day of the event!
