One of the best ways to help your pet feel more at home is by sending their usual food, pre-portioned into individual meal bags. This helps your pet stick to their regular diet and prevents upset tummies caused by sudden dietary changes.

If your pet takes medication, please be sure to include enough for their entire stay—plus 1–2 extra doses just in case of any unexpected delays or changes in your pickup schedule.

Also, don't forget to double-check that your pet's vaccination records are up to date! For everyone's safety, we require proof of current vaccinations before check-in.

Please do not send raw hide chews or rope toys. You are welcome to bring hard chew toys like nylabones or a kong. We have plenty of blankets & bedding here,
